### MS SQL Server: Disable Lock Escalation

MS SQL escalates from row to table locking if more than 5000 locks are allocated, which could lead to a down time in the system. To avoid it, the parameter LOCK\_ESCALATION is set to "DISABLED" for all tables by default.

## Accelerated Workflow Completion

Workflows in a system with the highest amount of already finished tasks are accelerated to ensure earliest possible completion.

- New key in the UC\_CLIENT\_SETTINGS variable: WF\_COMPLETION\_ACCELERATION ensures that active workflows are completed according to their amount of finished tasks.
- Recursive passing on of priority from parent to children workflows either via script elements or using the new checkbox on the UI.

## System variable UC\_SYSTEM\_SETTINGS includes two new keys for the Java Work Process (JWP).

JWP\_KEYSTORE\_PATH: The JWP uses the default path of the JRW keystore file. Now, this key can be used to set a path of your choice. Any network path defined by UNC or local paths are possible.

JWP\_KEYSTORE\_LOGIN: An alternative password for accessing the keystore file can be used if you reference a Login object in this key and modify the object accordingly.
